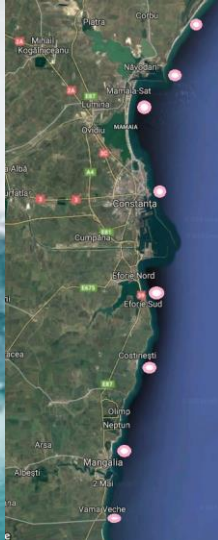

Monitorizarea deșeurilor marine pe coasta românească a Mării Negre 10 sectoare.



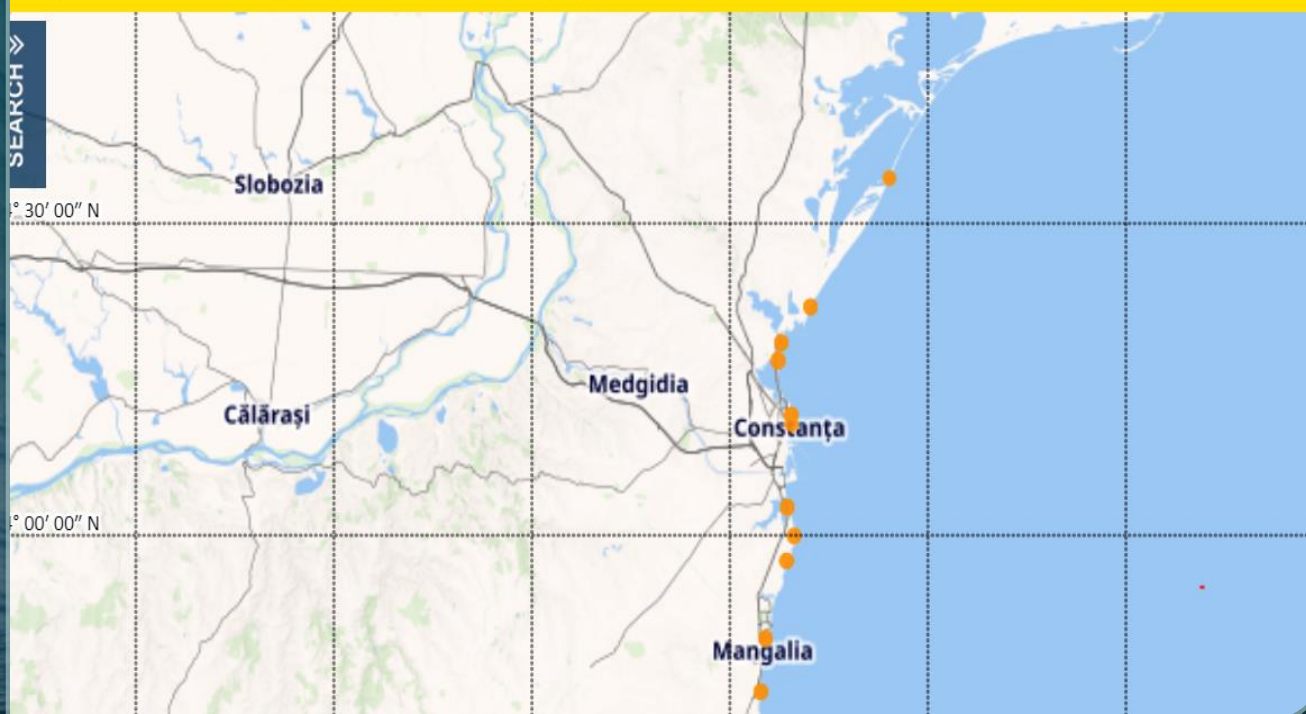

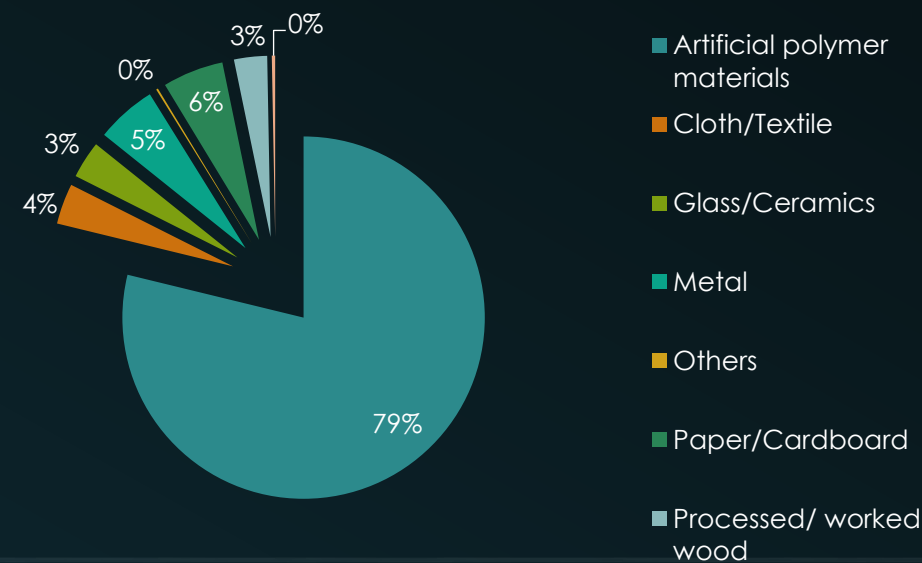

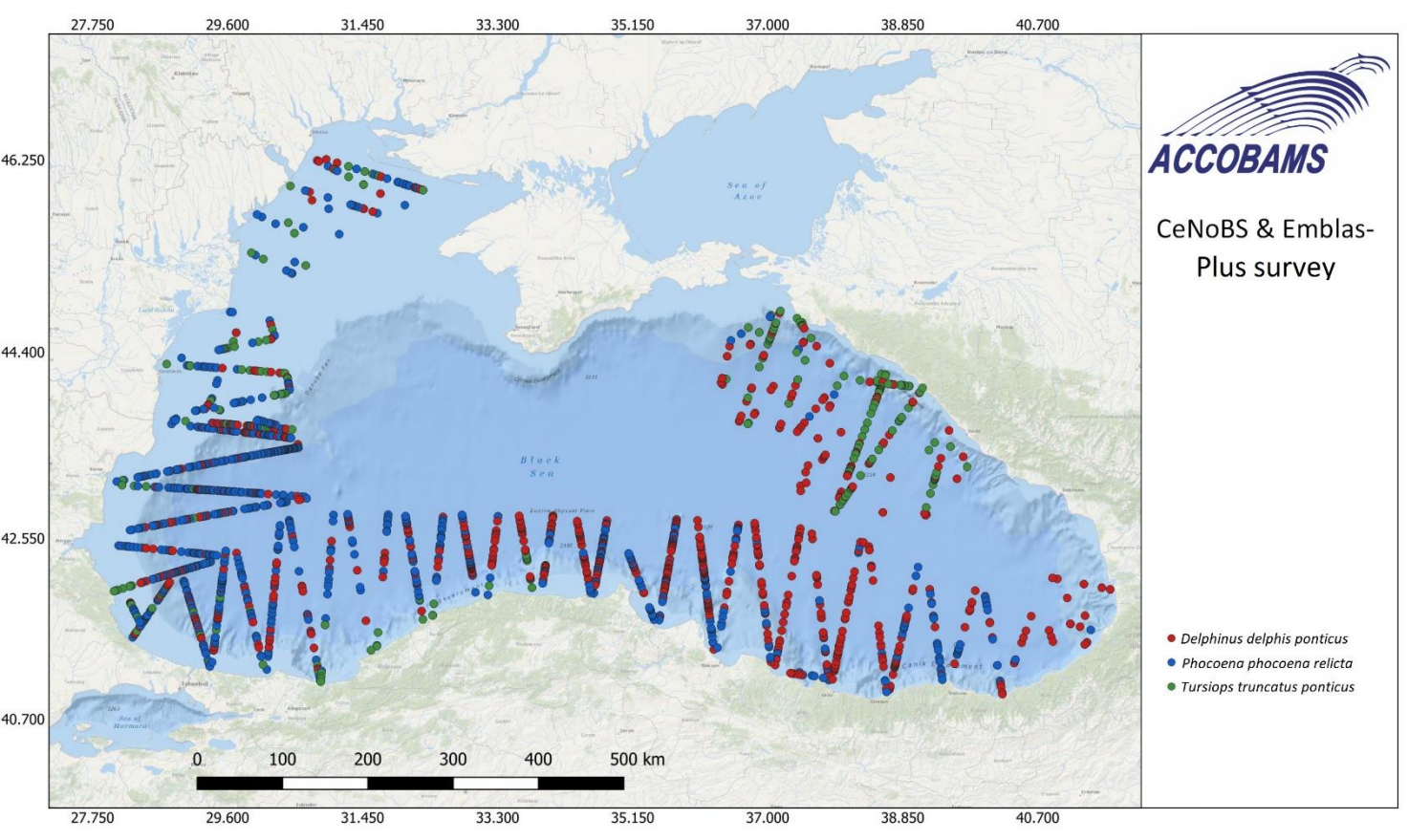


Situația actuală a deșeurilor marine

A BLACK SEA SUCCESS STORY

The largest cetacean aerial survey mission in the Black Sea!

After 3 weeks in June-July 2019 and 7,000 km surveyed, the most extensive aerial survey activity on cetaceans in the Black Sea basin was completed.

The aerial survey was conducted over the Black Sea waters in Romania, Serbia, Bulgaria, Turkey and Ukraine. It included aerial surveys, fish, birds, cetaceans, marine mammals, and marine invertebrates. These observations are used for enhancing the Biodiversity Observations and Sampling (BODS) the next members of the EU Marine Strategy Framework Directive (MSFD). The survey was carried out as part of the CeNoBS project (Supporting MSFD implementation in the Black Sea) through establishing a regional monitoring system of cetaceans (D1) and noise monitoring (D2) for the Black Sea. The project is co-funded by the European Union and the Government of Romania, the Government of Serbia and the Government of Bulgaria (ACCOBAMS).

Some specific team of 8 member countries of the Black Sea participated in the summer survey and 2 countries (Italy and Greece) joined the survey. The Black Sea basin is one of the most important areas of the Black Sea basin. It is considered as the component of the ACCOBAMS survey system - a network of marine protected areas, which represent an important step towards the implementation of the MSFD in the Black Sea with the aim to establish an integrated, collaborative and coordinated monitoring system to support the MSFD implementation in the Black Sea basin.

According to preliminary results, in 11 days and 7,000 km surveyed, more than 1,700 cetacean and marine mammal sightings were recorded. Harbour porpoises are by far the most numerous species, with 80% of the total sightings. Humpback dolphins (HD) and bottlenose dolphins (BD) sightings were also recorded. Cetacean population

Will be assessed through a regional aerial survey aimed at collecting visual sightings of Black Sea cetaceans. The aerial survey will be conducted in both territorial waters and include economical areas of Romania, Bulgaria, Turkey and Ukraine in the Black Sea.

Noise monitoring

The pilot studies for noise monitoring will allow to test methodologies applied in other marine areas and to define proposals and recommendations for D1 noise monitoring in the Black Sea.

By-catch monitoring

Pilot activities on cetaceans by catch monitoring will be implemented. Data will be collected through port questionnaire and on-board observers. Post-mortem necropsies of cetacean carcasses stranded ashore will be conducted as an independent estimation of bycatch rate with special focus on the HD/BODS.

Objectives

Marine Strategy Framework Directive (MSFD) represents the pillar of European Union, which aims "Good Environmental Status" (GES) in European marine waters by 2020. As well known, the Black Sea is one of the most vulnerable regional seas and Romania and Bulgaria are the European Member States responsible for implementation of MSFD in their jurisdiction (Romania and Bulgaria). This year project activities started in January 2019 to collect baseline data on the distribution and abundance of Black Sea cetacean populations, fishery pressure, and to implement effective noise monitoring in the region.

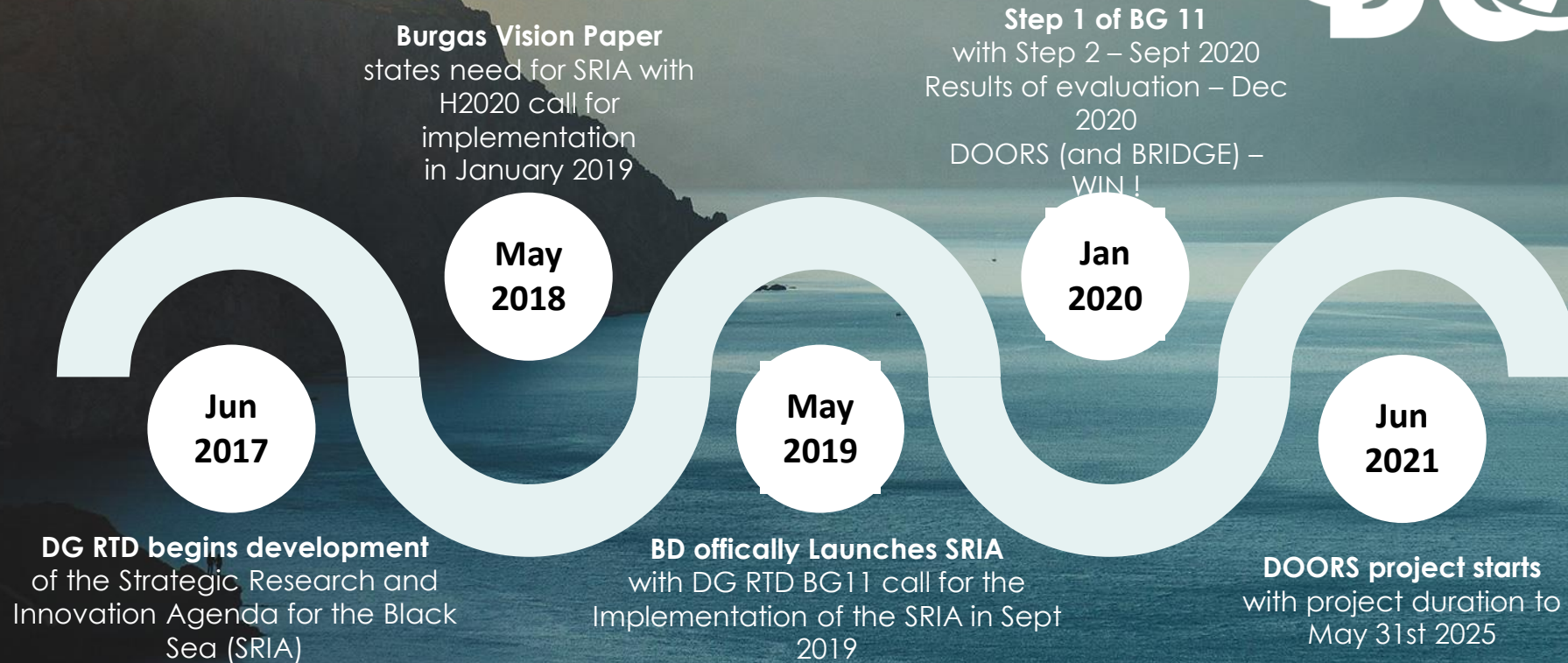
